### **2. Grades III & IV : Character Portrayal & Monologue**

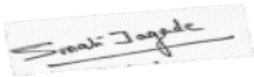
- **Theme:** *Pride of India*

- **Time Limit:** 1 minute
- **Language:** English
- **Judgement Criteria:** Costume authenticity, confidence, content quality, delivery/diction, and overall portrayal.

- **Last Date for Confirmation:** Please confirm your child's participation with their respective Class Teacher by **Monday, August 10, 2026**.
- **Audio Submission (Grades I & II ):** Send the edited audio track in MP3 format via labeled USB drive to the class teacher by **Wednesday, August 12, 2026**.
- **Props & Attire:** All costumes and props should be simple, safe, and brought/worn from home on the day of the event.
